

This document is designed to get you started with the iBX410W digital signage player. A [tutorial video](#) is also available to guide you through the installation of your player.

A. INSTALL THE PLAYER'S WI-FI ANTENNAS

Install the player's Wi-Fi antennas which are in the box with the iBX410W player.



B. CONNECT YOUR PLAYER TO THE SCREEN

The iBX410W supports HDMI 2.0. This means that you can connect your player to any display that has an HDMI slot.

Connect via HDMI

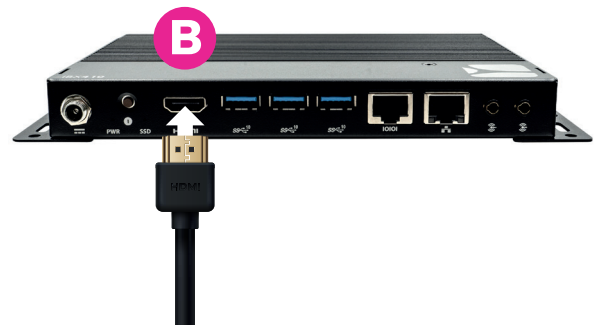
To connect the player to your screen via HDMI, you need a display with an HDMI connector and an HDMI cable (not included).

STEP 1:

Connect one end of the video cable to the HDMI port of your player.

STEP 2:

Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI port of the display.



C. CONNECT TO POWER

The player is powered by its power delivery unit.

STEP 1:

Connect the lockable power connector attached to the PDU to the power port (marked with the DC symbol).

STEP 2:

Connect the detachable cable to the PDU, then plug it into a power outlet.

STEP 3:

Press the player power button.

STEP 4:

Switch on the screen.



D. CONNECT TO THE WI-FI

At this point, an unconfigured player will automatically turn on its built-in Wi-Fi access point.

For a player that is not connected to the wired network, the screen shows the wireless network name and password.

You need to connect to the player access point and configure your player's access to your local wireless network, either with your PC or your mobile, following the steps detailed below. If you need more info, go to this page: support.spinetix.com/wiki/Wi-Fi_setup

On your mobile device

STEP 1: Scan the QR code with your phone's camera.

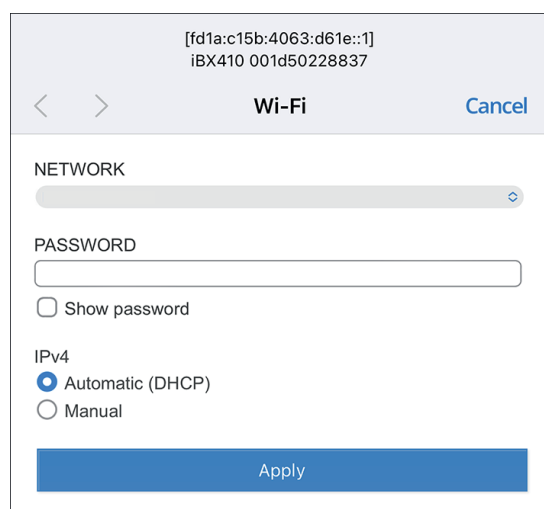
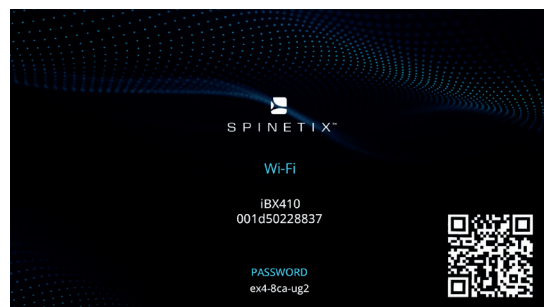
STEP 2: Click on the popup that appears and then click the "Join" button.

STEP 3: Go to your phone's Wi-Fi settings and tap on the iBX410W Wi-Fi network in the list.

STEP 4: In the Log In window that appears, enter your local wireless network details (SSID, username, password, etc.) in there. In case that doesn't happen, type <http://dsos.link> in your mobile's browser.

If needed, you can configure a static IPv4 address.

STEP 5: Click the "Apply" button and wait for the player to reboot.

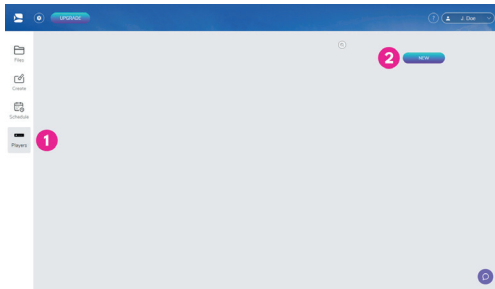


Special note: The iBX410W can also be connected to the network via Ethernet to provide you with more options.

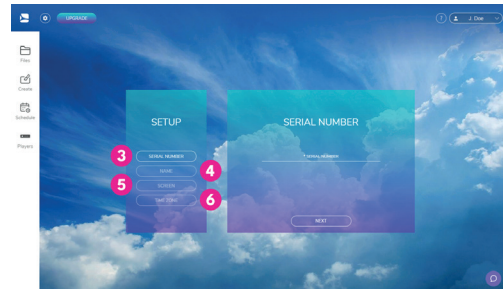
E. SET UP YOUR PLAYER IN SPINETIX ARYA



Go to arya.spinetix.cloud/setup and create your Spinetix ARYA account or sign in if you already have one.



- STEP 1:** Go to «Players».
- STEP 2:** Click on «NEW».
- STEP 3:** Enter the serial number of your player.

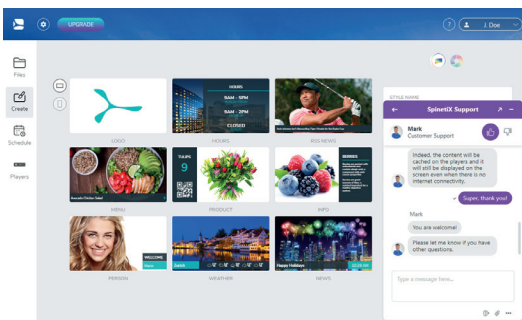


- STEP 4:** Name your player.
- STEP 5:** Choose the screen orientation.
- STEP 6:** Choose your time zone.

Wait for the player to reboot.

You can now start using your iBX410W player with SpinetiX ARYA.
