

HMP200 Not Recommended for New Deployments (NRND) Notice

SpinetiX has successfully introduced the third generation of HMP players in 2015. Consequently, first and second generations of HMP players has started the natural transition towards the End of Life. This notice is to inform you of our decision to issue the NRND Notice for HMP200 valid as of 1 January 2017. It is SpinetiX goal to make this process as seamless as possible to all our partners, and to provide as much visibility into what you can expect during the process.

What does NRND Notice stand for?

- NRND Notice informs the public that the life of the concerned product is coming to its end and that the product will not be produced any longer.
- NRND is a recommendation from the manufacturer not to position the product for new deployments anymore, but only for extensions.
- NRND Notice also implies that from the date of the announcement, the manufacturer can no longer guarantee the supply of the product, nor a replacement product with exactly the same features or for the same price.

What is the HMP200 migration path?

 HMP200 migration path is the HMP350. The HMP350 offers equivalent of all standard features of HMP200 at the same price.

What does the HMP200 NRND notice mean for customers?

 Customers with open bids, containing the HMP200 need to either ensure immediately the required stock of HMP200, or change the bid and replace the HMP200 with the HMP350.

Validity of NRND Notice?

HMP200 NRND is valid as of 1 January 2017.

When to expect EOL and EOW Notice?

A NRND Notice is not the same as an EOL (End of Life) or the EOW (End of Warranty) Notice. The EOL and EOW will
be communicated at the later stage.

• Please note that regardless of the NRND Notice, HMP200 remains under its standard warranty conditions.
